



Hummingbird Favorites

Hummingbirds zip through our area from early spring until September when they begin heading south to their winter migration sites.

According to the Audubon Society, hummingbirds need to eat every 10-15 minutes to sustain themselves. They visit between 1,000-2,000 flowers every day! Planting natives is a low-maintenance and cost effective way to attract and feed hummingbirds to your yard.

If you have a hummingbird feeder, remember to routinely clean it. Never use sugar substitutes or honey in the feeder, and leave out the red dye. Hummingbirds also need a balanced diet including small insects. Avoid using pesticides to help them find protein.
